TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY READING 9TH OCTOBER 2022

The episode of ten lepers follows from the parable of humble service read last Sunday. It again invites us to wonder at the gracious gifts of God. On his journey of Jerusalem, Jesus meets leprosy, an illness which cuts the sufferer off from worship and the presence of others. Like those poor in the psalms who call on the loving tenderness of the God of the covenant, the lepers cry out to the one in whom they discern a savior. IN sending them first to those who are qualified to verify a cure, Jesus not only makes them a promise, he also puts their faith to the test. For, at the moment, they are not yet cured. They are healed "on the way", by obeying Jesus' word. Thank filled with joy, but forgetful of the giver, they scatter.

There is one exception, a Samaritan, a foreigner! For him alone the journey of faith is not complete until he returns to the giver of the gift. Jesus continues the dialogue by sending him forth once more, this time as a disciple.


PROJECT ADVANCE 2022

From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Parishioners;

The plan to realize our new Parish Centre is ongoing.

There continues to be strides moving ahead with the Architect, the City and the Archdiocese.



Now, we are also looking at the best way to leverage the Cartier Hall property in order to fund the Construction of the New Parish Centre at the estimated cost of 16+ Million.

It is heart-warming to know that Parishioners have been so supportive of this project up to now.

Presently our weekly collection is about \$4000.

It is expected that the sale of Cartier Hall will aid in funding this project, but we estimate that we will still be burdened with a substantial mortgage.

The Parish Building Fund and your Pledge to Project Advance is crucial in bring this project to fruition.

Our gratitude for your thoughtful consideration to support these at this time.

It is hoped that more parishioners consider a pledge to Project Advance, no matter the amount; for a larger percentage of participation brings about a truly shared ownership of the building of the Parish Centre.

MAINTAINING A PRAYERFUL ENVIRONMENT



SOLEMN SUNG SUNDAY VESPERS & BENEDICTION occurs on Sundays at 3:30 pm.

THE GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS OF THE ROMAN MISSAL # 146 states that the people only rise after the Priest has said, "Pray Brethren that my sacrifice... be acceptable to the Almighty Father." and then they make their response: "May the Lord accept the sacrifice..."

THE COMMUNION ANTIPHON - is led by the Reader as the priest partakes in the chalice, others are encouraged to join in this.

ATTENTION READERS: - Reminder to Readers of Weekdays & Sunday Masses to make a deliberate pause of 20 full seconds after the First (& Second) Reading. For in this way, following the Lectionary instructions, the word of God—has time to enter through our ears to our heart. Thank you for your help in this way! An updated Instructional Card for Readers is found at the Reader's pew.

"WHEN CHILDREN CHATTER"- We ask that you take them for a walk, either to the family room on the left of the sanctuary or to the vestibule, which is now wired for sound. We appreciate your assistance in this matter so all the words of Holy Mass may be easily heard. Thank-you.

FAMILY WITH SMALL CHILDREN SEATING: On Weekends the left (east) back bench is reserved for parents with young children—even after Mass has begun. Thank you for your consideration & cooperation.

EXPIRED MISALETTES: Kindly do not leave old "Living with Christ", "Magnificat", etc... booklets in the Church after use. Please recycle them yourselves. Thank-you for your assistance.



REVERENTIAL SILENCE IN THE CHURCH:

"In the presence of the Angels I will praise you O Lord." (Ps 137.1) Having celebrated the Feast of the Archangels (Sept. 29th) and now of the Holy Guardian Angels (Oct 2nd) we are reminded that Angels presently minister to our Lord present in the Tabernacle here in our Church and that the primary purpose of our voice here is to offer Him praise in union with them. Especially before Mass, it is important to keep reverential silence in the church, in order to prepare for the Divine Liturgy. Gratitude for your cooperation and assistance.

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS TO ACCESS THE SEARCH ON FORMED

- Login into FORMED
- At the upper left corner find the search icon, it should be a blue magnifying glass, single click on it.
- On the line that pops up, type in "The Search" (Several choices will appear) 3.
- It is important to choose the playlist which should have a title screen to the right.





INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?

We believe that God calls individuals to live the Good News Jesus proclaimed and to become his disciples as members of the Catholic Church. If you want to become Catholic, you will participate in a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (sometimes called RCIA or simply Christian initiation). In RCIA, you will learn about the teachings of Jesus as the Catholic Church has handed them on put these teachings into practice by living as part of the Catholic community, serving others and praying.

A JOURNEY IN FAITH What does RCIA entail?

If you have NOT been baptized,

the Christian initiation process prepared you to become a Catholic Christian by celebrating the sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion.

If you have been baptized in another Christian tradition,

the initiation process prepared you to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church by celebrating the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion.

I'm a baptized Catholic, is RCIA for me?

If you have been baptized as an infant, but have not received further formal instruction in the Catholic Faith nor the sacraments of Confirmation or the Eucharist, RCIA is indeed for you. If you have fully initiated Catholic who wishes to deepen your faith, contact the Parish Office about the possibility of participating.

How long does it take to become a Catholic?

Becoming Catholic is a life-long commitment. However, the Christian initiation process typically lasts for few months in order to prepare to take this step. Participants in the initiation process generally meet at least once a week. Here at Sts. Peter & Paul our program will begin, Tuesday, September 27, 2022 @ 7:00 pm at our Parish Church. Father will use the program called, "The Search" (7 weeks program) found in our FORMED database. The Second part will take place in the New Year. The initiation of individuals who are ready to make the commitment to become new members of the Catholic Church usually

take place at Easter (Easter this coming year is Saturday, April 8, 2023).


