THIRTIETH SUNDAY READING 23RD OCTOBER 2022

One creates a caricature by taking a significant trait, exaggerating it, and making it larger than life. This is how Jesus sets up the two extremes of religious attitudes in his day.

The Pharisee asks nothing for himself. He is undoubtedly no hypocrite. What he says, he does to perfection. Unfortunately, he is preoccupied with himself and is judging others. He is interested in God primarily as the one who will reaffirm the merits he lists.

In contrast to this religiously active man stands the tax collector. He does not make a prayer of thanksgiving. He confesses, not out of a need to clear his conscience, but to express all the pain that he is feeling. Finding nothing which can give him assurance before his judge, he throws himself on the diving mercy. It is from that mercy that he hopes to receive his life as a grace of gift.

This humble man goes home justified but the other does not. The Christian knows that the just one is never more than a person who has been justified, saved by God, beyond all merit.



REVERENTIAL SILENCE IN THE CHURCH:

THE PASSING OF FATHER JOHN HORGAN



It is with a heavy heart that we announce the passing of our friend and past Pastor, Father John Horgan.

Fr. John Horgan was the Pastor of Saints Peter & Paul parish from 1998—2013.

Father John was born in the USA in 1958. He studied at Harvard University and completed seminary studies in Rome. Pope St. John Paul II ordained him to the priesthood on May 25, 1986.

Father served the Archdiocese in many ways, sitting on numerous councils and committees; and he was chaplain to Vancouver General, St. Paul's and Mount St. Joseph Hospitals; to the Knights of Malta and the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem; to the Musqueam Band; and to Vancouver College.

His first pastorate was Sts. Peter and Paul's Parish in Vancouver, from 1998-2013, followed by St. Pius X Parish in North Vancouver, and finally, Immaculate Conception Parish in Vancouver.

Throughout his whole life Fr. Horgan loved reading, amassing a collection of over 14,000 books and even writing his own, on Angels, as well as numerous articles.

Many will remember Fr. Horgan eloquently speaking about the Saints he knew and loved, and whose relics he collected over the years.

Let us remember Father Horgan in our prayers, along with his family.

Hear with favour our prayers,
which we humbly offer, O Lord,
for the salvation of the soul of John, your servant and Priest,
hat he, who devoted a faithful ministry to your name,
may rejoice in the perpetual company of your Saints.
Through Christ our Lord.

INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?

How long does it take to become a Catholic?

Becoming Catholic is a life-long commitment. However, the Christian initiation process typically lasts for few months in order to prepare to take this step. Participants in the initiation process generally meet at least once a

week. Here at Sts. Peter & Paul our program

will begin, Tuesday, September 27, 2022 @ 7:00 pm at our Parish Church. Father will use the program called, "The Search" (7 weeks program) found in our FORMED database. The Second part will take place in the New Year. The initiation of individuals who are ready to make the commitment to become new members of the Catholic Church usually take place at Easter (Easter this coming year is Saturday, April 8, 2023).
