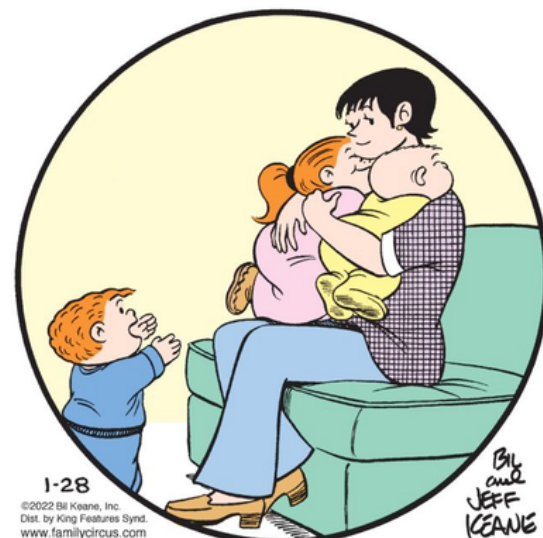

CORPUS CHRISTI Sunday Reading

Blood, the symbol of life, is sprinkled both on the altar, the sign of God's presence, and on the people to be faithful. God and Israel are henceforth united by living covenant. When Moses came to the people & related all the words & ordinances of the Lord, they all answered with one voice. "We will do everything that the Lord has told us." Moses then wrote down all the word of the Lord & rising early the next day, he erected at the foot of the mountain & twelve pillars to the twelve tribes of Israel. Then, having sent certain young men of the Isralites to offer holocausts & sacrifice young bulls as peace offering to the Lord, Moses took half of the blood & put it in the book of the covenant, he read it aloud to the people,who answered, "All that the Lord has said. we will heed & do." Then he took the blood & sprinkled it on the people, saying. "This is the blood of the covenant which the Lord has made with you in accordance with all these word of his."

Today, we celebrate Solemn Sung Vespers & Benediction of Corpus Christi.

After the Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, those present are also invited to kneel at the rail to receive a personal blessing.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

The Conference of Bishops gives directives to how to physically receive Holy Communion.

Today's Feast warrants a refresher for us all. Unless one is infirmed, these norms are to be followed. In this way, the priest knows that you are practicing & attentive, for he is the guardian of ensuring reverence for the Blessed Sacrament.

When receiving on the hand, either kneeling or standing, the following are the Church's directives:

- Make a cross with hands, left on the right, slightly cupped (Father should not touch your hand, not too cupped)
- Take the host with your underneath right hand & place in your mouth (& perhaps then make a sign of the cross)
- If kneeling, then stand & return down the aisle to your seat, only after you have received.

Not to Do:

- Stand & walk away before receiving
- Put the host in your mouth with hand of receiving (scooping).

POPE BENEDICT XVI ON CORPUS CHRISTI. The Eucharist, a call to holiness and self-giving.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is inseparable from Holy Thursday, from the Mass in Caena Domini, in which the Institution of the Eucharist is solemnly celebrated. Whereas on the evening of Holy Thursday we relive the mystery of Christ who offers himself to us in the bread broken and the wine poured out, today, on the day of Corpus Christi, this same mystery is proposed for the adoration and meditation of the People of God, and the Blessed Sacrament is carried in procession through the streets of the cities and villages, to show that the Risen Christ walks in our midst and guides us towards the Kingdom of Heaven.

What Jesus gave to us in the intimacy of the Upper Room today we express openly, because the love of Christ is not reserved for a few but is destined for all. In the Mass in Caena Domini last Holy Thursday, I stressed that it is in the Eucharist that the transformation of the gifts of this earth takes place — the bread and wine — whose aim is to transform our life and thereby to inaugurate the transformation of the world. This evening I would like to focus on this perspective.
