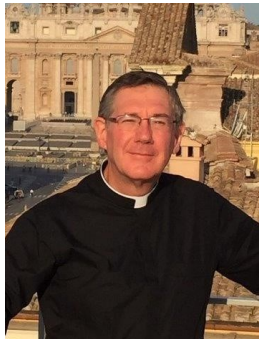

READINGS: THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

We might take it for granted that good news is the essence of Christianity. Yet we often conceive of it as a collection of beliefs, a system of spiritual & moral strictures inherited from those who received them from God and transmitted them infallibly to the Church.

At the origin of Christianity, there was no celestial indoctrination with divine truths, sprung from the First Truth. It was rather by a decisive event that faith began. God's good news is his Son Jesus. He can say: "The kingdom of God is here, because he himself is here. In him and through him, God establishes his kingdom by actively saving humanity.

In his regard, the great fisherman is Jesus himself. He attracts people not with vinegar but with the proclamation of good news. That is the savor of Christian belief. The sacraments, the beatitudes, the Church, the forgiveness of sins are all good news summarized in Jesus, revelation of a Father full of tenderness. To welcome this conviction, to follow Jesus unconditionally is faith, conversion. It is not mere intellectual assent to a collection of inherited truths.

SPECIAL CEREMONIES FOR THE EPIPHANY...

1. Proclamation (after the Gospel) of the Date of Easter:

Know, dear Brethren (brothers and sisters), that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Saviour.

On the 31st of March we will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ

On the 12th day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the 19th day of May, the feast of Pentecost.

On the 2nd day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the 1st day of December the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ to whom honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

2. Epiphany Blessing of the Home: the gold sheet next to the bulletin provides the text for the Blessing of your home.

The Blessing occurs with the use of Pre-Blessed Chalk that Father provides for you to take to use and write as instructed.

"May this blessing remain on this home and all who dwell herein. Amen."

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

An update on our New Parish Centre Project to be built on the west side of the Church: (1450 W 38th and 1449 W 39th and the lane in between these): Virtually, the city has given necessary approval to move ahead. Our challenge now is to finance this. The total construction cost is estimated at 14.5 Million. We have an offer to purchase Cartier Hall for 8.5 Million. This means that we still need to raise 6.5 Million to pay for this project. Our present parish cash flow only covers operating expenses. Extra donations are required; including by contributions to the Parish Building Fund & Project Advance. An overview of the entire New Centre Building (one long one going from 38th to 39th): the 38th side (2 stories) would be the Great Parish Hall (named after Sts. Peter & Paul) with a connecting kitchen (named after St. Andrew the hospitality apostle). Nearby (on the Church side) would be the Conference Hall (named after St. James the Great) towards 39th would be the Adoration Chapel (named after St. John the Beloved). West of these (towards the neighbour: 1459 W 39th) would be the Office Wing (named after St. Matthew the tax collector). Upstairs on the 39th side would be more meeting rooms (named after all the other Apostles). Below all this would be underground parking and elevators throughout. These 12 rooms would be dedicated by the donor as they so pleased. If you might be interested in doing this, please let me know. I can't help but to remember that this Centre was Fr. John Horgan's dream; thus the Chapel of Adoration will be named after his patron. In the meantime, also, our Project Advance campaign for 2023 continues to assist this project, pledge forms for this are next to the bulletin. Our gratitude for your kind consideration in these matters that can bring about the needed growth to our parish life.
