

lesus, the Son of Man, is on the road which leads to His passion. Although His message jars the disciples' expectations, He nevertheless strives to draw them after Him. Unwittingly, and often unwillingly, they are to become messengers of a suffering Messiah.

"What were you discussing on the way home?" They are arguing about who will be the greatest in that temporal kingdom which they anticipate. Accustomed to humiliation, they dream of advancement to positions of prestige and power. "You want to be the first?" says Jesus, "Become the last! You want to be great? Become small! You want to be masters? Become servants!" This example which the suffering servant Himself never ceases to give.

And what do we discuss on the way home? Perhaps we too would be embarrassed if Jesus were to question us. In speaking about what is closest to our hearts, we reveal the depths of ourselves. You dream of authority, of power? Ask yourself how you will best serve others, how you will best help those in need. So must it be with every Christian eager to conform with Jesus.
