"Happy are you." Our consumer society claims to give us happiness, but we know very well that it is incapable of doing so. The beatitudes present a wholly different perspective.

To the poor, to the hungry, to those who weep and are rejected, Jesus declares: "Happy are you." To the rich, to be powerful, to the satisfied, to the clever, he declares: "Woe to you."

Those who recognize that God is their only hope will be satisfied beyond measure; whereas those who presume that the sustenance of their lives depends on their own achievement are doomed to fail.

The church in our way cannot afford to support the false hope of a consumption-oriented society. Wealth and power, money and armaments, will not bring happiness. Only those wo seek the kingdom of God fillwind all else besides (Luke 12:31). "Better is the scanty store of the just than the great wealth of the wicked, for the power
